## MuRFy's World Classroom

## Outreach Programme

All pupil activities link eco issues with real world examples, encouraging the pupils to think about resources and waste at school and home. Engaging the whole school community is important when taking action on behaviour change to tackle eco issues.

### Assemblies

Reduce, Reuse, Recycle or food waste and compost assemblies are available for KS1, KS2, KS3 and KS4.

### Lessons

Lessons are available for KS1 – KS4 and link waste and recycling with many areas of the curriculum. Please call us to discuss your particular requirement.

### Eco Committee or School Council meetings

Talks and activity workshops about the 3Rs or food waste and compost help your pupils brainstorm, plan and take action on environmental issues at school.

### Reuse craft workshops

We run creative workshops with waste including junk modelling, paper making, paper jewellery, bottle top mosaics, plastic bag knitting, or any other creative request!

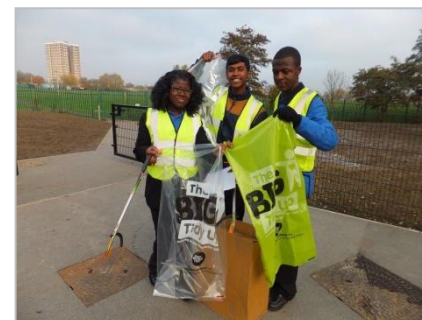
### Waste audits

With the help of pupils we run classroom waste and recycling audits and lunch waste audits to help the school monitor the waste produced.

### Staff training

Short talks and workshops to cover topics including the 3Rs, Get Composting! and Eco Schools awards.

### Lorax Library

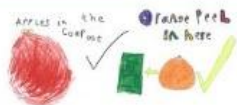
